

RESIDENTS CAMPAIGN FOR BETTER PARK SECURITY

At a public meeting held on Saturday 21 November, Panshanger Councillors Darren Bennett and Sara Johnson agreed to support the residents' petition for an automatic barrier to stop cars entering Moneyhole Lane car park late at night. The meeting was attended by 41 residents, local police and the ward councillors.

For years the residents near Moneyhole have been plagued by inconsiderate car owners playing loud music, racing and indulging in anti social behaviour in the Council owned park managed by Finesse Leisure. "The police cannot patrol the park at all hours. Preventing car entering the park will stop these late night disturbances and the youths who gather around the vehicles" says Ian Barnes, a local resident.

A petition signed by 159 residents was presented to the Council's Social Overview and Scrutiny Committee on Monday 23 Nov. 09. The petition was canvassed when residents sought a permanent solution to this long standing problem.
